This month, Wheelchair Transport Service (WTS) saw significant advancements. Driver safety scores rose to 80.2%, up from 59.18% last year. 98.08% of Return Ready trips were completed within 60 minutes. Stretcher transports increased by 15% compared to last March. WTS was selected as one of eight top-tier transport companies nationwide for the Mobility Advisory Board Meeting. We promoted a top-performing driver to Field Supervisor for stretcher training, welcomed two excellina field. drivers in the and new implemented visual safety measures in our fleet. Additionally, all stretchers were professionally serviced, ensuring top-notch service.

Reflective Safety Vests: WTS is increasing driver safety in the evenings by having our second shift drivers wear new reflective safety vests.

Visual Safety Tape: We are starting to highlight our vehicle entrances with new visual safety tape to ensure the safety of our drivers and passengers. Safety Stickers: Recently, we added "Allow 9 Feet for Clearance" and "No Texting and Driving"

stickers to remind our drivers to always be alert. Safety Scores Icon on tablets: New feature on tablet allows drivers to view their safety scores, why their score has gone up or down, and footage of harsh events detected.
